
Key Highlights of the Month

foundit Insights Tracker in Malaysia recorded a modest 2% increase in e-recruitment in July 2023 from a year ago level.



The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) marked an index of 78 in July 2023 from 77 in July 2022.


- MoM, the growth in e-recruitment remained steady and unchanged with June 2023 also maintaining an index of 78, indicating an unvarying trend.
- As per the tracker's data, there has been noticeable 3% growth observed over the last six months. The recruitment landscape in Malaysia is currently in a state of swift transformation, primarily fueled by emerging technologies. This dynamic shift is ushering in an exciting phase for the country's workforce, characterized by the emergence of fresh opportunities across industries.



Hiring Trends – Industry*

Online recruitment activity expanded in 6 out of 10 industries monitored by the tracker between July'23 and July'22

- In July'23, the Retail (+74%) industry demonstrated an exceptional growth rate of outpacing growth in all industry sectors. The noteworthy upswing can be attributed to an increase in demand, particularly propelled by the heightened sales in general merchandise stores. Followed closely by the Hospitality (+63%) industry driven by the strong emphasis on digital transformation and the advancement of intelligent product offerings.
- On the contrary, the IT, Telecom/ISP, BPO/ITES (-22%) industry marked the most significant decline among all sectors. The downturn is the consequence of the sector's weakened growth on the global scale. Furthermore, Oil and Gas (-11%) along with BFSI (-8%) industry experienced a sudden and notable drop in hiring demand, positioning them among the industries with the least growth in hiring demand during July'23.
- Among others, Production/Manufacturing, Automotive and Ancillary (+3%) Advertising, Market Research, Public Relations, Media and Entertainment (+4%), Logistic, Courier/ Freight/ Transportation, Shipping/ Marine (+8%) and Engineering, Construction and Real Estate (+13%) noticed the substantial hiring demand in the month of July'23




Hiring Trends - Functional Area*

Online recruitment activity surpassed the year-ago level in 4 of the 10 occupation groups monitored by the tracker

Hospitality & Travel (+71%) roles maintained a robust demand in July'23 with soaring sectoral growth. Additionally, a noteworthy uptick in hiring demand for Sales & Business Development (+33%) and Marketing & Communications (+8%) roles was registered. These figures underscore the increasing demand for innovative job roles majorly in the Retail sector.

The Customer Service (-45%) roles saw plummeting growth, marking the most significant negative growth among all monitored functions. Also, the Purchase/ Logistics/ Supply chain (-8%) along with Finance & Accounts (-5%) roles witnessed a decrease, reflecting a decline in annual demand in July'23.

Among other categories, **HR & Admin** (-1%), **Software, Hardware & Telecom** (-4%) along with **Engineering/ Production, Real Estate** (-5%) function marked the subsequent drop in hiring demand in July'23 from the year-ago level.



Data & Methodology

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since March 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since March 2014.
