Key Highlights of the Month

foundit Insights Tracker in the Philippines saw a substantial drop of 13% in e-recruitment activity in July 2023 from July 2022.



The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) registered a decline from an index of 132 in July 2022 to 115 in July 2023.

- The hiring demand witnessed a 7% dip on the month on month basis, as June 2023 saw an index of 124.
- Over the past three months, a 9% decline has been observed in online recruitment activity. The tracker depicts a noticeable deceleration in the online hiring space. The data highlights a delicate state within the realm of e-recruitment.


Hiring Trends – Industry*

Online hiring demand in July'23 exceeded the year-ago level in 2 of the 12 industries monitored by the tracker

In July'23, the Healthcare (+11%) industry maintained its position with the most robust year-on-year growth, showing an impressive increase in e-recruitment. Additionally, the BPO/ITES (+5%) sector experienced consecutive annual growth recording notable rise during the same period.

The Logistics, Courier/ Freight/ Transportation, Shipping (-40%) sector witnessed a substantial decline annually in July'23, representing the lowest annual job demand within the industry. Also, the Advertising, MR, PR, Media
& Entertainment (-26%) and Education (-25%) sectors experienced a slowdown in growth momentum.



Among other monitored sectors, Engineering, Construction and Real Estate (-1%), Consumer Goods/ FMCG, Food & Packaged Food (-3%), BFSI (-13%), Production/Manufacturing, Automotive and Ancillary (-14%), Hospitality (-18%) and IT, Telecom/ISP (-23%) saw a subsequent annual drop in July'23.

Hiring Trends - Functional Area*

Online recruitment activity surpassed the year-ago level in 3 of the 10 occupation groups monitored by the tracker

- The demand for Healthcare (+14%) professionals remains strong, indicating a significant increase and marking the most noteworthy annual growth in July'23. Also, Customer Service (+8%) roles experienced a rise, while roles in Software, Hardware, Telecom (0%) saw muted hiring demand, both reflecting a resilient and optimistic growth trajectory in July'23 annually.
- Within the spectrum of monitored functions, the HR & Admin (-30%) roles witnessed the sharpest annual decline, Followed closely, by the Purchase/ Logistics/ Supply chain (-25%) and Sales & Business Development (-23%) job roles marking the notable drop. Also, Marketing & Communications (-22%) function observed a substantial annual dip in hiring in July'23.
- Among others, Hospitality & Travel (-4%) Engineering/ Production, Real Estate (-4%) and Finance and Accounts (-11%) recorded a sequential drop in demand annually in July'23.



Functional Area Trends

Data & Methodology

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since February 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since February 2014. foundit has taken due care in compiling and processing the data available from various sources for foundit Insights Tracker (fit), but does not guarantee the accuracy, adequacy or completeness of any information and is not responsible for any errors or omissions or action / decision taken or for the result obtained from the use of such information.
