#### **Hiring Trends in India**

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
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#### **Key Highlights of the Month**

foundit Insights Tracker in India records an 8% decrease in hiring activity in India.

- The foundit Insights Tracker revealed an 8% decline in employer hiring activity in September 2023 compared to the previous year, with the index falling from 277 in September 2022 to 255.
- In comparison on a monthly basis, there was a 2% contraction in the index, as August 2023 marked an index at 260.
- While the tracker indicates a deceleration in online hiring, certain industries are experiencing a resurgence, providing a crucial boost to job creation. Anticipated is an upswing in hiring momentum in the coming months. Yet, the paramount focus remains on re-skilling and upskilling employees, imperative for navigating the dynamic job market landscape and mitigating the effects of the growing prevalence of artificial intelligence.



#### **Hiring Trends – Industry**

On an annual basis, e-recruitment activity witnessed a robust surge in 10 out of the 27 industries.

- The substantial month-on-month growth seen in the **Retail** (+9%) and **Home Appliances** (+11%) sectors is directly linked to the onset of the festive season. This surge signifies an upswing in consumer activity, resulting in escalated demand, consequently driving an increased need for hiring in these sectors.
- Furthermore, there was a year-over-year and month-over-month uptick in hiring within the **Automotive/Ancillaries/ Tyres** sector. This upward trend is closely associated with the surging demand for skills pertinent to electric vehicles (EVs) and the expanding adoption of digitization strategies to enrich the overall customer experience.

#### **Hiring Trends – Functions**

Online hiring demand outpaced the year-ago level in 4 out of 13 functional areas monitored by the tracker.

- Legal (+21%) professionals experienced a substantial surge in hiring activity over the past month, resulting in robust annual growth. The trend is notably influenced by the increasing significance of alternative legal service providers in the industry.
- Also, **Marketing & Communications** (+6%) roles saw increased demand, fueled by the sustained need for digital marketing and public relations professionals. This uptick underscores the industry's growing reliance on experts who can navigate the evolving landscape of digital marketing and communication strategies.

#### **Work model Trends**

In the current landscape marked by a global economic slowdown, we find ourselves amidst an employer-centric market. Despite this, there remains a discernible employee preference for flexibility and an improved work-life balance.

Current figures reveal that 21% of job opportunities are structured around a hybrid work model, and only 12% are designated for full-time remote work. Intriguingly, job seekers actively seeking opportunities in these flexible work arrangements stand at 49% for hybrid roles and 28% for fully remote positions. This inconsistency between the demand for flexible work and the available opportunities underscores the persistent importance job seekers place on work models that offer a blend of in-office and remote options.

The IT-Software and Services sector dominated the distribution of remote and hybrid job opportunities, claiming the highest share at 47%. Following closely, the Recruitment, Staffing, and RPO sector secured a notable presence with 21%, emphasizing the industry's responsiveness to flexible work models. Additionally, the Advertising, Market Research, and Public Relations sector secured a 6% share, highlighting a moderate inclination towards remote and hybrid work arrangements.

#### **Data & Methodology**

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index ) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since January 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since February 2014.
