

Key Highlights of the Month

foundit Insights Tracker in Malaysia recorded an 11% year-on-year increase in e-recruitment in September 2023.

- The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) reveals a notable growth, with the index ascending from 71 in September 2022 to 79 in September 202, marking a positive trend in the reported period.
- MoM, the tracker maintained a stable index of 79 in September 2023, demonstrating stability compared to the previous month, with August'23 also registering an index of 79.
- According to the tracker, a robust growth of 8% has been noticed over the past six months. Although the job market has remained steady since last month, it is crucial to highlight the positive momentum witnessed in various industry sectors on a month-to-month basis. This momentum is driven by the favorable conditions in the domestic economy.



Hiring Trends – Industry*

7 out of 10 industries monitored by the Index registered expansion in recruitment activity in September'23 annually.

- The Retail (+108%) sector saw a significant jump in September 2023 annually attributed to the festive demand, followed by the Hospitality (+82%) which grew further with the rising confidence among investors towards the industry and maximizing profits with the increased tourist demand. Additionally, Engineering, Construction and Real Estate (+23%) also marked a remarkable growth in hiring activity in September'23.
- Conversely, the **IT, Telecom/ISP, and BPO/ITES** (-17%) sector sustained a cautious approach to hiring, exhibiting the lowest hiring demand among all monitored industries. Similarly, **Oil and Gas** (-13%) and **BFSI** (-11%) industries experienced a substantial annual decline coupled with a notable decrease over the previous month.
- However, Production/Manufacturing, Automotive and Ancillary (+5%)
 Advertising, Market Research, Public Relations, Media and Entertainment (+11%) industries registered a substantial annual growth in September'23. Also, hiring demand in Logistic, Courier/ Freight/ Transportation, Shipping/ Marine (+22%) saw a consecutive surge.




Hiring Trends - Functional Area*

Online recruitment activity surpassed in 7 of the 10 occupation groups annually in September'23.

Hospitality & Travel (+177%) roles experienced an extraordinary surge in demand, recording a remarkable growth in September'23 fueled by the heightened demand for regional tourism. Also, the function saw a substantial hiring growth of 48% over the last three months. Additionally, Sales & Business Development (+42%) and Marketing & Communications (+9%) roles also witnessed positive annual growth in September'23.

The Customer Service (-43%) roles persist in their downward trend, marking a substantial decline across all monitored functions. Also, Finance & Accounts (-3%) positions registered a decrease, while Purchase/ Logistics/ Supply chain (-1%) witnessed a marginal dip annually.

Among others Engineering/ Production, Real Estate (+1%) roles showcased a positive trend in September'23 annually while HR & Admin (+1%), and Software, Hardware & Telecom (+1%) although marginal, experienced a continuous uptick in e-recruitment activity in September'23.



Data & Methodology

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since March 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since March 2014.
