Key Highlights of the Month

foundit Insights Tracker in Malaysia noted a 16% annual upsurge in e-recruitment in October 2023.

- ✓ The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) highlights significant growth, with the index climbing from 69 in October 2022 to 80 in October 2023, signifying a positive and noteworthy trend during this period.
- ✓ MoM, the tracker witnessed a marginal increase as September 2023 marked an index of 79, reflecting a positive job market.
- ✓ The tracker has indicated a gradual but consistent upward trend observed over the past six months, underscoring positive momentum within multiple industry sectors. This encouraging trajectory is notably influenced by favorable conditions prevailing in the domestic economy.

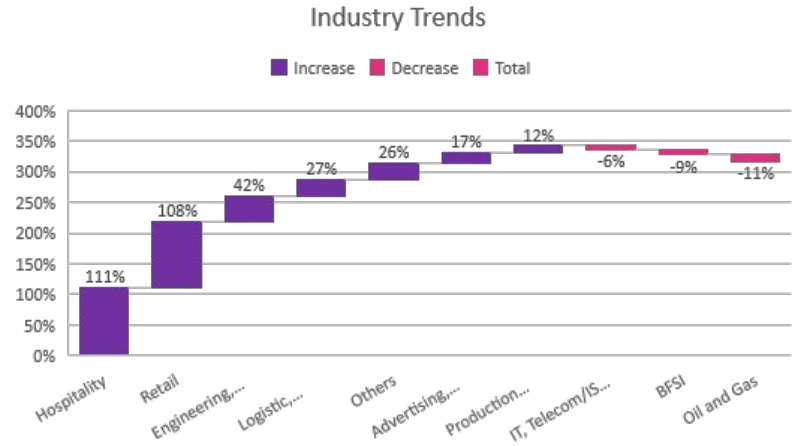

Hiring Trends – Industry*

7 out of 10 industries monitored by the Index registered an annual increase in hiring activity in October'23.

- ✓ The **Hospitality** (+111%) sector experienced a substantial annual surge due to the resurgence of tourism activities, attributed to a rise in tourist arrivals and heightened spending followed closely by the **Retail** (+108%) sector marking a spectacular annual growth in October 2023 attributed to surge in the convenience stores activities. Furthermore, Engineering, Construction, and Real Estate (+42%) also marked impressive growth in hiring activity annually and month-over-month in October '23.
- ✓ The **Oil and Gas** (-11%) sector faced a notable annual decline but showed positive growth in the last month. Meanwhile, **BFSI** (-9%) continued its trend of negative growth. Although the **IT, Telecom/ISP, and BPO/ITES** (-6%) sector experienced an annual dip there was a 4% growth in hiring activity over the last month in this sector.
- ✓ However, **Production/Manufacturing, Automotive and Ancillary** (+12%) **Advertising, Market Research, Public Relations, Media and Entertainment** (+17%) industries registered a substantial annual growth in October'23 . Also, hiring demand in **Logistic, Courier/ Freight/ Transportation, Shipping/ Marine** (+27%) saw a subsequent increase.



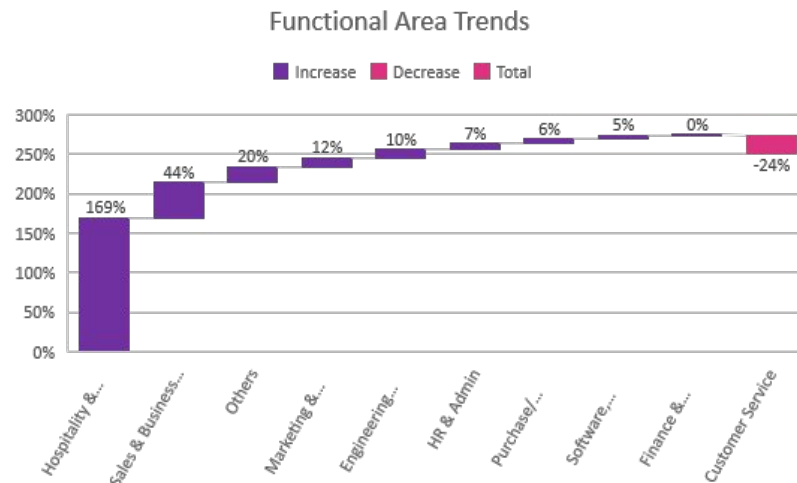
Hiring Trends - Functional Area*

Online recruitment activity surpassed in 9 of the 10 occupation groups annually in October'23.

✓ **Hospitality & Travel** (+169%) roles saw an exceptional surge in demand in October'23, driven by heightened domestic demand. Furthermore, the sector experienced double-digit hiring growth over the last month. Additionally, **Sales & Business Development** (+44%) and **Marketing & Communications** (+12%) roles also demonstrated positive annual growth in October'23.

✓ While **Customer Service** (-24%) roles sustained a decrease in annual demand, being the sole function to exhibit a negative growth trend, they experienced a notable 19% increase over the last month. Furthermore, **Finance & Accounts** (0%) professionals saw a muted demand annually in October'23.

✓ Nonetheless, **Engineering/ Production, Real Estate** (+10%), **HR & Admin** (+7%), **Purchase/ Logistics/ Supply Chain** (+6%) and **Software, Hardware & Telecom** (+5%) roles experienced a noteworthy growth in e-recruitment activity in October'23.



Data & Methodology

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since March 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since March 2014.
