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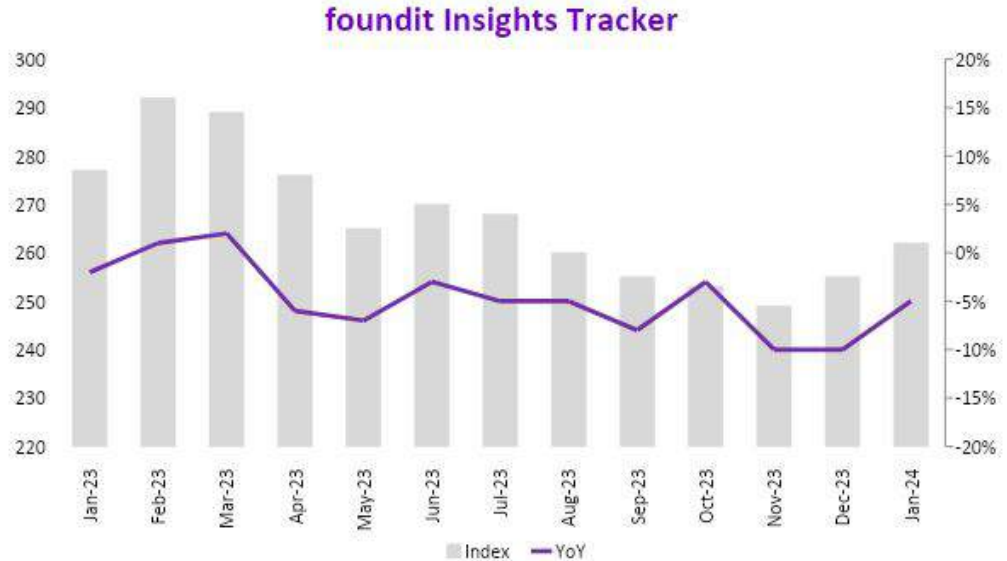


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Key Highlights

foundit Insights Tracker in India marked a 5% dip in e-recruitment activity in January'24

- ✓ In January 2024, the foundit Insights Tracker documented a 5% decline in hiring compared to the corresponding period the previous year, indicating a reduction in the hiring index from 277 in January 2023 to 262.
- ✓ The job demand saw a 3% increase on a month-on-month basis, as December 2023 saw an index of 255.
- ✓ According to the tracker, a 5% growth has been registered over the last three months. month-on-month expansion signifies a positive shift in online hiring sentiments, in contrast to the relatively elusive growth observed over the past year. The trajectory suggests that as a nation, we are moving in a promising direction, marked by more organized initiatives for sustained employment generation in the long term.

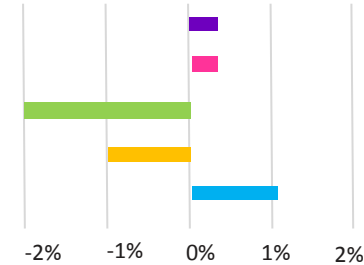

✓ The **Telecom/ISP** sector exhibited significant growth in January 2024, with a notable increase of 5% compared to the previous month. The surge can be attributed to organisations leveraging emerging technologies such as **Generative AI** and diversifying their services into sectors like **FinTech, supply chain management, AR/VR, and cybersecurity**.



Also, **BFSI** (+5%) witnessed an increased hiring demand over the last month, particularly in **tech and HR-related roles**.

✓ The sector saw significant growth in all the locations monitored by Tracker **except Pune**.

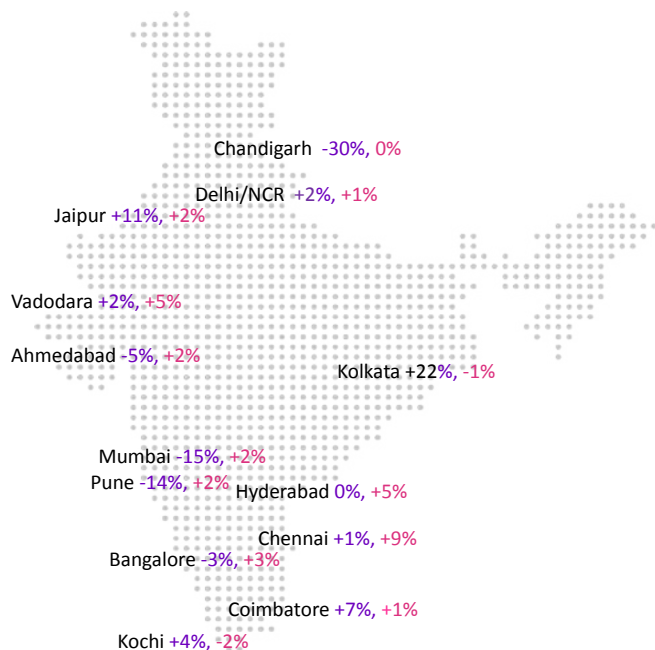
Online demand exceeded the year-ago level in 4 out of 13 functional areas monitored by the tracker.

-  **Marketing & Communications** (+7%) job roles have experienced remarkable growth in January'24 compared to last month along with a substantial 12% increase over the past six months. The growth is primarily driven by a heightened demand for professionals skilled in **digital marketing and analytics**. While the positive trend is observed across various cities, **Delhi/NCR** stands out with the highest surge, recording a noteworthy **5% increase in the last month** alone.
-  **Legal** professionals witnessed significant growth, marking a notable 7% increase in demand over the past month. The rising demand is particularly evident in the field of **Mergers and Acquisitions advisory**.

Hiring Trends - Across Cities

E-recruitment activity exceeded the year-ago level in 8 of the 13 cities monitored by the fIT.

Work model Trends

The year 2023 introduced the concept of hybrid flexibility for front-line workers, especially in Healthcare. Also, **Pre-emptive relaxation** was encouraged by organisation aiming to sustain emotional resilience and performance amongst employees, shifting away from viewing rest merely as a recovery solution after both aspects have declined.

In 2023, when employees “**quiet quitted**”, the organizations flipped the script by adopting “**quiet hiring**” strategies, a method to acquire fresh skills and capabilities without the need for expanding their full-time employee base.

The data suggests an almost similar trend in 2024 when compared to 2023, the hybrid work model is still prevalent. Although we are in the midst of an employer-centric market due to the global economic slowdown, the employees still choose flexibility and better work-life balance. According to the current figures, 21% of jobs account for hybrid work and a mere 9% for WFH while the **job seekers seeking hybrid and remote job opportunities are still 44% and 17% respectively.**

The **IT sector** continues to lead in the remote job landscape, contributing **44% of both permanent and temporary remote job** postings online. The breakdown comprises **31% for hybrid** roles and **13% for fully remote** positions, experiencing a notable **14% decline on a year-over-year** basis. As organizations navigate the evolving work landscape, the growing emphasis on workplace flexibility has sparked discussions around **the adoption of a four-day workweek**, indicating a broader shift towards innovative approaches to work-life balance.

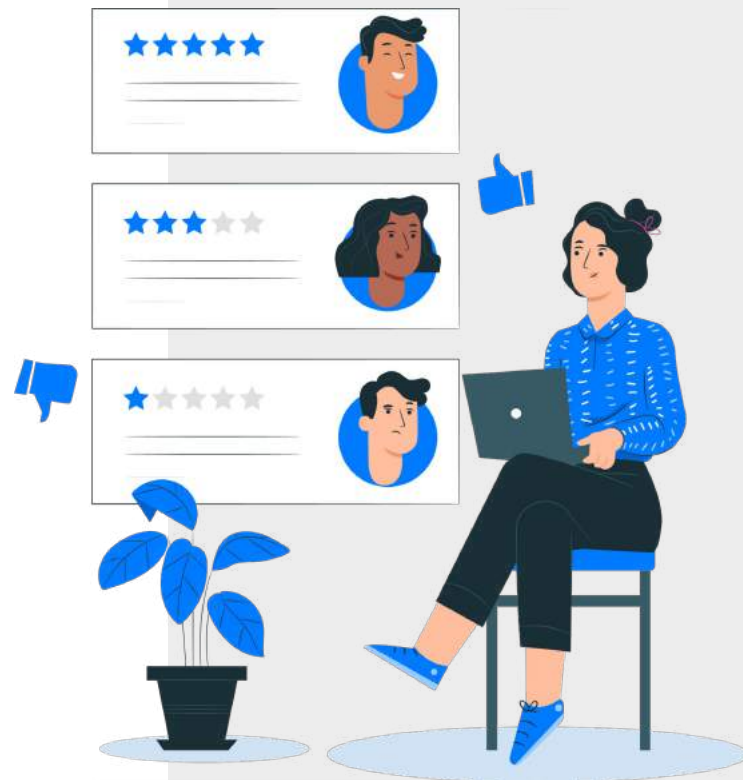

Data & Methodology

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since January 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since February 2014.

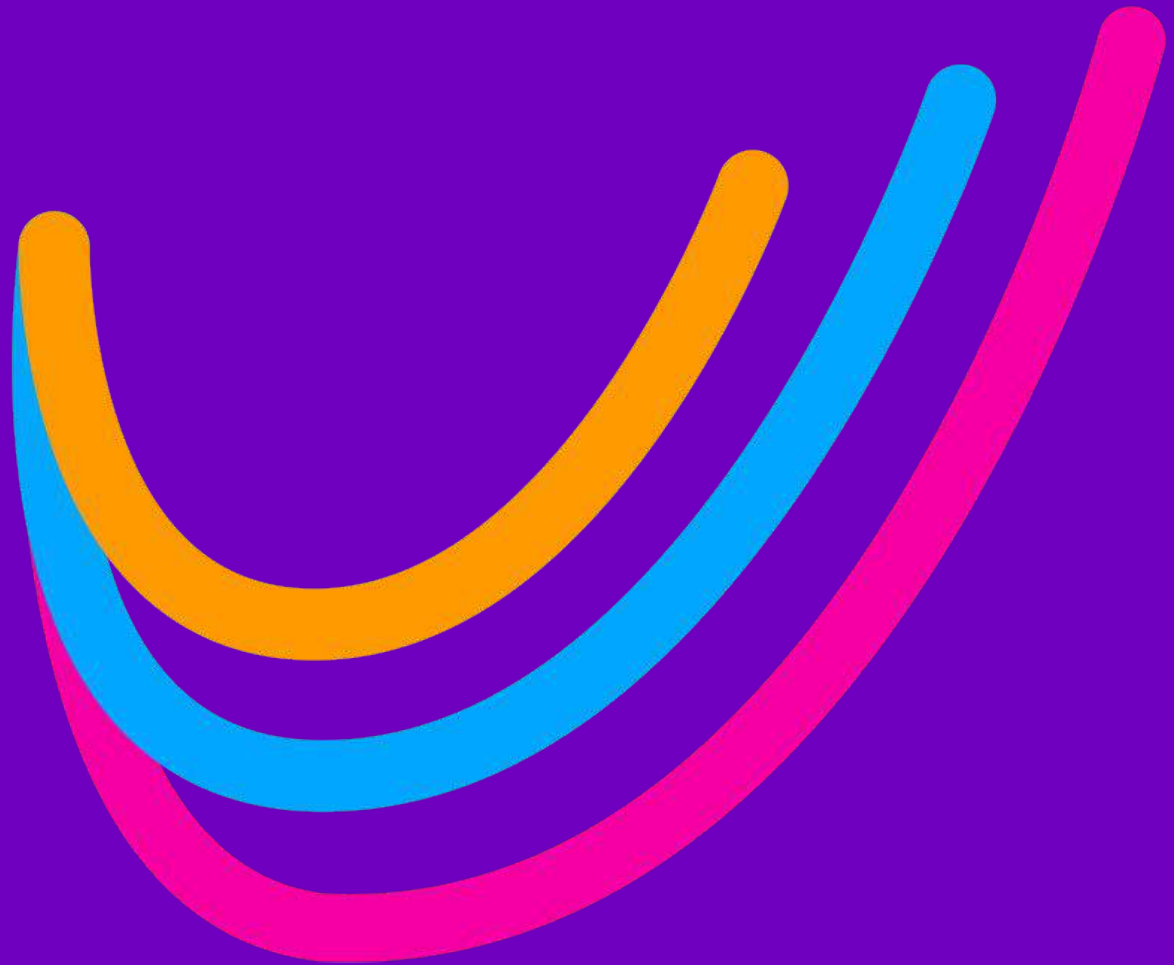
