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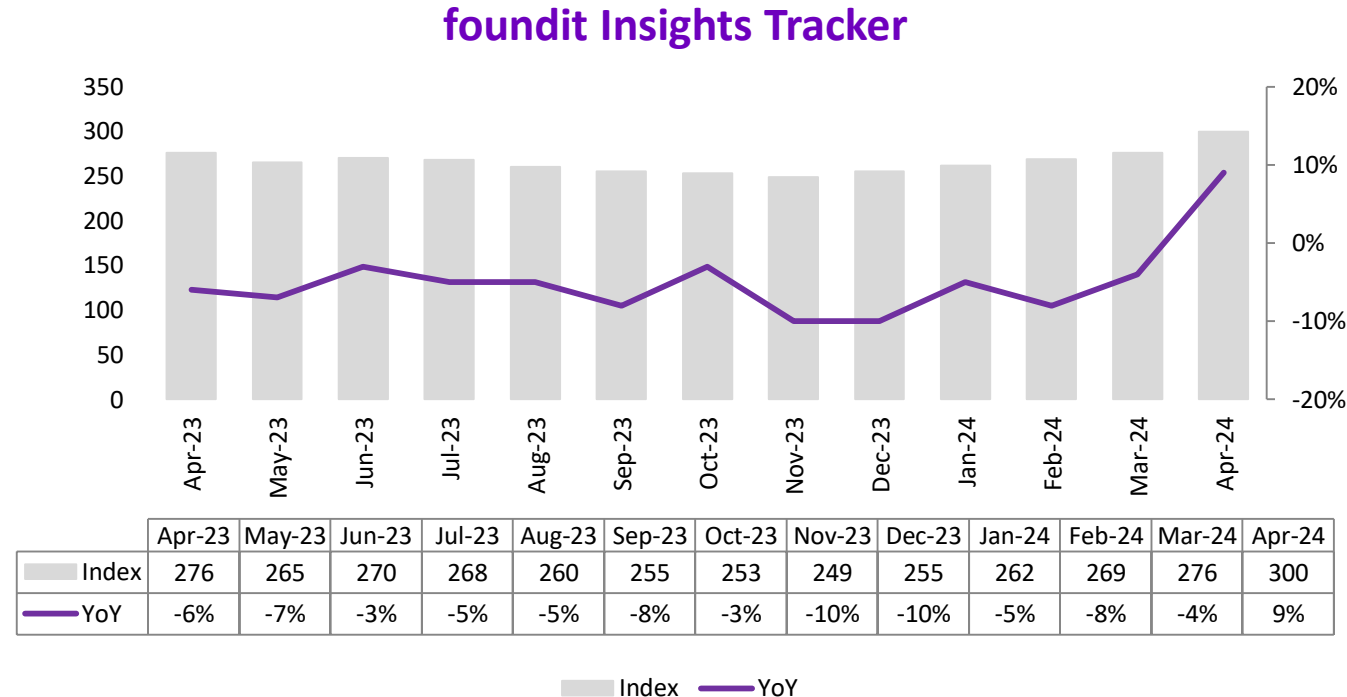


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Key Highlights

foundit Insights Tracker reveals a 9% annual surge in e-recruitment activity for India in April'24

- ✓ The most recent data from the foundit Insights Tracker indicates a significant uptick in hiring activity, with a 9% increase observed in April 2024 compared to the previous year. This upward trend is further illustrated by the rise in the index from 276 in April 2023 to 300 in April 2024, highlighting a positive shift in hiring trends within the specified timeframe.
- ✓ Comparing month-to-month data, there is a robust 9% increase in hiring activity, as the index stood at 276 in March 2024.
- ✓ According to the tracker's data, there has been a steadfast growth trajectory, with a 20% increase over the last six months and a 12% rise over the previous three months. This resurgence signals renewed optimism within India Inc., as the recruitment market gains momentum. Foreseeing continued growth in the coming quarters, this reaffirms a positive hiring outlook for the current year.

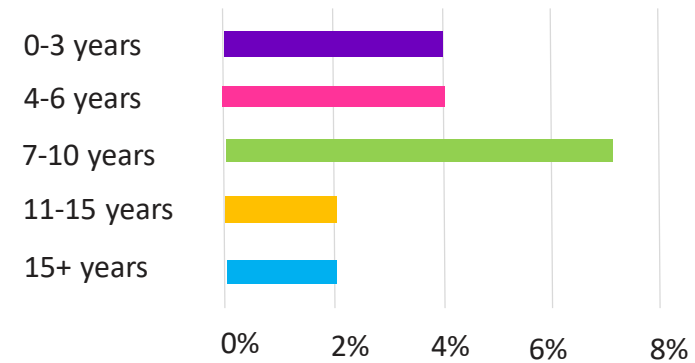

Hiring Trends – Industry

The tracker noted an uptick in recruitment activity across 17 of the 27 industry sectors annually in April 2024.

✓ **Production and Manufacturing** (+31%) witnessed significant hiring growth, with a remarkable increase annually as well as on a monthly basis. The surge indicates a revival within the sector, providing a crucial boost to job creation and reinforcing the economy's foundation. The heightened demand in this sector can be attributed to substantial investment inflows in FY23, particularly in Automobile, Chemical, Pharmaceutical, and Food Processing industries.

✓ Moreover, **IT – Hardware, Software** (+9%) experienced a significant upturn, registering notable growth both annually and on a monthly basis. This remarkable expansion can be largely attributed to the increasing prominence of GCCs. Furthermore, the sector's growth is fueled by investments to address the ongoing shortage of IT talent and the widespread adoption of immersive experiences facilitated by 5G, AI/ML, and spatial computing technologies.

Hiring Trends – Functions

6 out of 13 functional areas monitored by the tracker witnessed an uptick in hiring demand annually

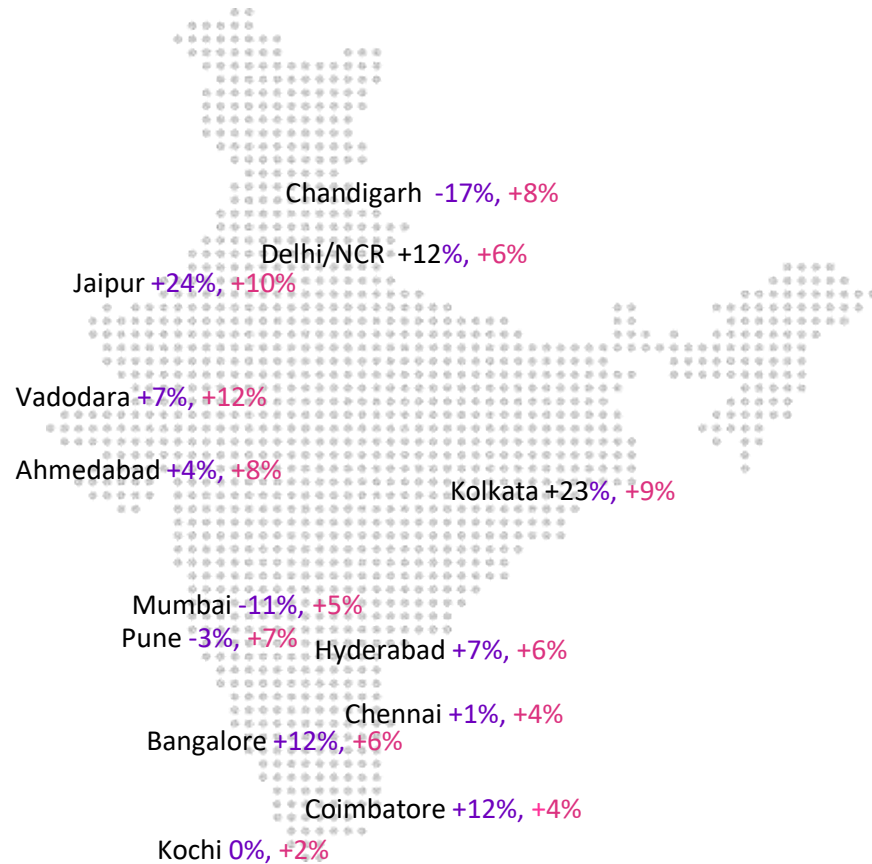

✓ **Marketing & Communications** (+12%) function saw significant hiring growth this month with a major focus on skills such as hyper-personalization by data, analytics, and automation. Also, **Healthcare** (+10%) witnessed a robust hiring demand, driven by the need to build intelligent tools and incorporate sustainability practices into digital ecosystems.

✓ **Software, Hardware, Telecom** (+2%) professionals noticed a consecutive hiring growth annually as well as from monthly perspective in April'24. While growth was observed across all monitored cities, tier 2 cities notably contributed to the majority of the growth. Additionally, Delhi-NCR stood out with a significant 11% growth rate.

Hiring Trends - Across Cities

E-recruitment activity exceeded the year-ago level in 10 of the 13 cities monitored by the FIT.

Startup Trends

While there has been a **37% increase in the number of startups** since the same time last year, the **number of jobs has increased by 14% only**. Also, **Freshers constitute 53% of these jobs**, The gap between the rapid growth of startups and the relatively slower pace of job creation suggests underlying structural hurdles from issues such as limited access to funding, regulatory complexities, and mismatches in skill supply and demand. Notably, there's a growing reliance on assessments to navigate the skill gap challenges and ensure suitable hiring practices. Tackling these structural barriers is imperative to foster a more equitable and sustainable growth path that optimizes the socio-economic advantages of the startup surge.

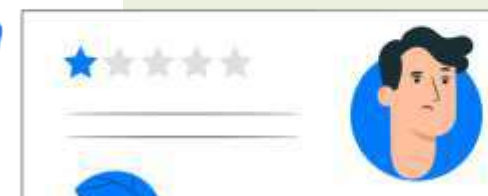
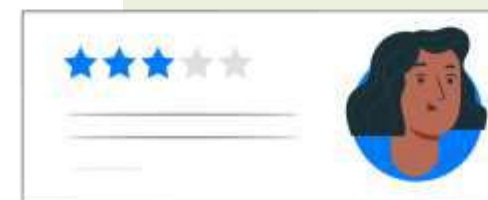
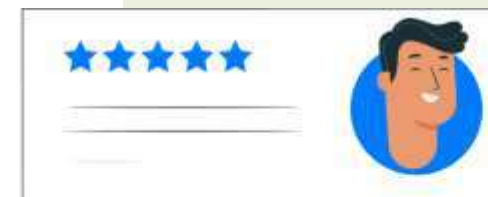

Data & Methodology

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since January 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since February 2014.
