Key Highlights of the Month

foundit Insights Tracker in Malaysia reports a significant 9% rise in hiring demand annually in February 2024.

- The foundit Insights Tracker (FIT) indicates a promising trend of expansion, with the Index rising from 76 to 83. This upward movement reflects a positive shift in the job market from February 2023 to 2024, signaling encouraging growth and advancement in hiring activities on an annual basis.
- On a month-over-month basis, the tracker noted a 5% decline, with January 2024 showing an index of 87.
- The tracker has indicated a gradual but consistent upward trend marking a 5% growth observed over the past six months, underscoring positive momentum within multiple industry sectors. This encouraging trajectory is notably influenced by favorable conditions prevailing in the domestic economy with the growing startups in the region.



Hiring Trends – Industry*

6 out of 10 industries monitored by the Index registered an annual increase in hiring activity in February'24.


- The **Retail** (+148%) sector has shown an impressive annual growth, sustaining its upward trajectory primarily due to the expansion of flagship units and robust consumer demand. Additionally, the **Hospitality** (+83%) sector has witnessed a substantial surge annually, reflecting strong double-digit growth. Furthermore, the **Engineering, Construction, and Real Estate** (+59%) sector displayed significant annual growth driven by notable Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) opportunities in industrial hubs alongside technological advancements.
- The **BFSI** (-28%) sector saw a consecutive drop annually followed by the **Oil** and **Gas** (-22%), witnessing a sharpest annual decline. Also, **IT, Telecom/ISP, BPO/ITES** (-7%) sector recorded an annual dip amidst global headwinds.
- The Logistic, Courier/Freight/Transportation, Shipping/Marine (+24%) demonstrated excellent growth, with a noteworthy 39% increase over the last three months benefiting from the ongoing global supply chain shift. Similarly, Advertising, Market Research, Public Relations, Media and Entertainment (+18%) sector saw an annual increase in demand recording an upsurge. Conversely, the Production/Manufacturing, Automotive, and Ancillary (-4%) observed a decline in hiring activity in February'24 on YoY basis.



Hiring Trends - Functional Area*

Online recruitment activity outpaced in 5 of the 10 functional areas annually in February'24.

- The. **Engineering/Production and Real Estate** (+48%) roles witnessed remarkable growth amidst green economic development goals. Furthermore, **Sales & Business Development** (+42%) professionals saw an exceptional surge in demand in February'24 followed closely by **Marketing & Communications** (+41%) roles witnessing a substantial hiring demand.
- Finance & Accounts (-13%) roles saw a significant drop annually in February'24 attributed to the reduced demand in the BFSI sector. Additionally, Purchase/Logistics/ Supply Chain (-11%) along with Hospitality & Travel (-3%) and Software, Hardware & Telecom (-3%) registered a drop in hiring demand annually in February'24.
- Among others, the job demand surged for **Customer Service** (+19%) roles experiencing a robust demand annually along with the double-digit growth over the last month. The growth reflects the evolving needs of businesses to prioritise customer satisfaction and support in an increasingly competitive market environment specifically in Retail sector. Additionally, **HR & Admin** (+18%) roles saw substantial gains annually, with an impressive increase.

Data & Methodology

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since March 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since March 2014.
