June hiring trends in India

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Executive Summary

As we reach the halfway mark of 2024, it's time to revisit our predictions from the foundit Insights Tracker of December 2023 and evaluate the progress so far.

Online hiring activity has maintained its upward trend, showing a robust 12% year-on-year growth in June 2024. This aligns with our forecasted 8.3% increase for the year.

Additionally, Bengaluru is witnessing a surge in hiring, further expanding into Tier-2 cities, as predicted, driven by tech sector growth and urban development.

Positive Outlook

The tracker's data indicates a 15% increase over the last six months, maintaining the resolute growth rates. This re-affirms a positive hiring outlook for the current year.

The Manufacturing sector has seen significant hiring growth, driven by investments in Automobile, Consumer Electronics, and Textile & Apparel sectors. This surge is crucial for job creation and economic strength.

Similarly, the Construction & Engineering sector has experienced a 26% increase in online hiring over the last six months, spurred by sustainability and green initiatives.

The agriculture sector has faced steady challenges over the past year, with a significant drop of 20% in September 2023. However, recent months show signs of gradual recovery, with the rate of decline easing from April onwards. Growth in organic farming and advanced agritech, along with e-farming applications, is also contributing to this positive trend.

While the job market outlook remains positive, there is a continued focus on re-skilling and upskilling employees to adapt to the dynamic job market and the impact of increasing Al adoption.

June hiring surge led by Manufacturing, Textile & Apparel

The tracker observed an increase in recruitment activity across 20 out of the 27 monitored industries on an annual basis in June 2024.

The **Renewable Energy** sector is powering up the manufacturing industry, with a big push on sustainability creating jobs in green manufacturing and related fields. It's not just the big cities; tier-2 cities like **Chandigarh** and **Coimbatore** have seen double-digit growth in hiring over the past month, showing how opportunities are spreading far and wide.

The **Textile & Apparel sector** is on a roll too, thanks to tech advancements, sustainability efforts, government support, and growing domestic and export markets. There's a high demand for job seekers with skills in modern manufacturing technologies, sustainable practices, and international trade. Plus, tier-2 cities like **Surat** are seeing a **hiring boom** as companies look beyond traditional hubs for expansion.

Hospitality, Marketing & Communications take the spotlight among functions

8 out of 13 areas saw an uptick in hiring. New hotel openings and high demand for talent are driving growth in Hospitality, Marketing & Communications.

Hospitality roles (+36%) are seeing a surge, mainly due to the need for experienced leaders to manage hotel operations. With nearly 100 new hotel properties set to open this fiscal year, the demand is only getting stronger. Additionally, roles in **airport operations** are on the rise, thanks to the development of numerous new airports.

On the flip side, **Sales & BD (-6%)** roles took a hit. The shift to digital sales has changed the game, with companies now investing more in digital marketing and automation tools, cutting down the need for large sales teams.

E-recruitment soared in 8 of 13 cities annually, led by Bengaluru (+24%) & Coimbatore (+23%). Jaipur, Delhi-NCR, and Hyderabad also showed strong gains, highlighting expanding opportunities in tier-2 cities.

India's D&I hiring surge: record growth & bold new initiatives

Bengaluru, Mumbai, & Delhi-NCR lead the way in D&I hiring, especially in BFSI & IT. But seasonal hiring spikes show the need for a steady diversity hiring push all year round.

Diversity hiring in India has surged by 33% year-over-year, underlining the growing importance of diversity and inclusion (D&I) policies. While there are seasonal peaks, particularly around Pride Month, the overall trend remains positive with notable spikes in June 2023 (37%) and May 2024 (57%).

The BFSI sector leads with the highest share of diversity jobs at 30%, up from 25% last year, reflecting robust efforts to enhance inclusivity. This is followed by IT - Software & Services with 19%, Healthcare at 6%, Internet/E-commerce at 4%, and Education at 3%. These sectors are driving the demand for diverse talent.

Job postings now prominently feature inclusive language, specifying preferred pronouns and avoiding gender bias. Additionally, there is a strong push to promote women to leadership roles through mentorship and specialised training programs.


The future of diversity hiring in India looks promising. With a continued focus on D&I policies, technological integration, and regional expansion, the country is poised to foster a more inclusive and dynamic workforce. This ongoing commitment will ensure that diversity hiring becomes a year-round effort, creating sustained opportunities for underrepresented groups.


Diversity Hiring Trends

Delhi-NCR (22%) leads in PwD hiring, while Bengaluru (16%) leads in D&I hiring. Category-wise, women represent 53% of diversity hires, PwD 2% and D&I 45%.

About the report

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since January 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since February 2014.
