July hiring trends in India

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# Executive Summary

The foundit Insights Tracker indicates a robust hiring outlook across key sectors, driven by supportive government policies and economic recovery. The Union Budget has laid the foundation for a robust employment and skill development landscape, focusing on key sectors and technological advancements.

# The tracker's data reveals a 11% increase in hiring over the last six months, continuing the consistent upward trend.

Although month-on-month hiring demand remains steady, there is a positive hiring surge among employers, maintaining a steady pace since the beginning of the year. The Consumer Electronics sector has experienced significant hiring growth, supported by the expanding semiconductor industry.

Similarly, the IT- software & services sector saw a 21% annual increase and a 17% rise in hiring over the last six months, with substantial opportunities in emerging technologies, software development, and product management

Moreover, the IT-Software & Services sector offers the highest salary packages. The Retail sector witnessed double-digit salary growth for entry-level positions, while Advertising, Market Research & PR sectors reported the highest salaries for experienced professionals.

Despite the hiring spree, a significant supply gap persists, underscoring the need to addressthis mismatch for sustained growth. This year's Union Budget aligns with this need, emphasising the importance of equipping the younger generation with essential skills.

What's good to see is the government's focus on enhancing vocational training programs, promoting digital literacy, and supporting innovation in emerging technologies. Additionally, the emphasis on public-private partnerships is expected to boost job creation and better align workforce capabilities with industry demands.

# E-Recruitment soars 11% annually in July '24

In July 2024, India's e-recruitment landscape saw a robust 11% annual growth, reflecting a significant uptick in hiring activities across various sectors. This surge underscores the positive momentum in the job market, driven by increased demand for talent in key industries such as IT and Manufacturing.

Despite a slight 1% month-on-month decline, the overall hiring activity remains strong, signaling confidence in economic recovery and growth.

Salary growth across most sectors has been positive and consistent over the past year. The IT- software & services leads with the highest salary packages followed by the Retail, Advertising, Market Research and PR.

foundit Insights Tracker in India registered a marginal decrease in hiring activity over the last month.



# July hiring shows growth driven by Consumer Electronics, Manufacturing and Real Estate

The tracker observed an increase in recruitment activity across 18 out of the 27 monitored industries on an annual basis in July 2024.

The Consumer Electronics sector is on a robust growth trajectory fuelled by advancements in white goods and the Semiconductor industry, and driven by the adoption of AI, IoT and 5G. Strong hiring demand was registered in Bengaluru (11%), Hyderabad (11%) and Chennai (10%) over the past month across various roles, including Engineering, Research & Development and Product Design.

The Real Estate sector experienced strong hiring demand annually as well as over the last month. The surge can be attributed to the increasing need for flexible spaces, data centers and rising investor confidence. Global investors are showing renewed confidence in the Indian market, leading to more projects and job creation. Notably, Chennai and Jaipur have witnessed the double-digit growth in hiring demand over the past month.

Medical roles (+22%) are seeing a surge, mainly due to the growing awareness about health and wellness, boosting the need for healthcare professionals across industries. Additionally, innovations in medical technology and telemedicine are expanding the scope of healthcare services, requiring skilled professionals to manage and operate new technologies.

Engineering & Production (-7%) roles saw a decline. Advancements in technology are changing the nature of engineering and production roles. The rise of digital twins, advanced simulations, and smart manufacturing require different skill sets leading to the consolidation of roles. Additionally, there is a growing focus on sustainability and green technologies, leading to shifts in engineering and production roles towards more specialized fields.

- Retail saw a notable 15% increase for 0-3 years of experience and 14% for 4-6 years.
- The IT-Software & Services sector leads with the highest salary packages.
- Industries such as Automotive, Travel & Tourism, and Telecommunications show varying trends based on experience levels. Automotive sees a decline of 8% for 0-3 years but a 4% increase for 10-15 years of experience.

# About the report

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since January 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since February 2014.
