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Executive Summary

The foundit Insights Tracker reveals steady growth, with tech-enabled industries leading the charge.

AI-driven roles are seeing increased demand across tech sectors. Global Capability Centres (GCCs) are not only propelling IT growth but also sparking innovation across multiple industries, creating fresh job opportunities, particularly in emerging cities.

The tracker highlights steady growth, with hiring up 8% over the past six months.

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) for August 2024 reports a robust 15% year-on-year growth in hiring, driven by substantial gains in the IT and Real Estate sectors. The IT industry continues to be a powerhouse, with a remarkable 23% increase in annual hiring, with Global Capability Centres (GCCs) driving much of this demand, making up 62% of IT jobs, with a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 27.66% since 2021.

The Real Estate and Construction & Engineering sectors also saw impressive growth, with hiring rising by 32% and 31% annually, respectively. This momentum is particularly evident in cities like Chennai and Hyderabad, where Construction and Engineering roles are booming.

Tier-2 cities are quickly becoming hiring hotspots. Coimbatore saw a 4% month-on-month rise, establishing itself as a growing tech hub alongside established tech hubs like Bengaluru, which recorded a 5% MoM and 14% YoY increase in IT hiring.

In terms of specific roles, IT continues to lead, with high demand for software development, data science, and DevOps professionals. The Medical and Marketing & Communications sectors are also on the rise, reflecting the sustained need for digital and healthcare expertise.

Overall, we anticipate more stability and growth in the coming months, creating new job prospects in the market

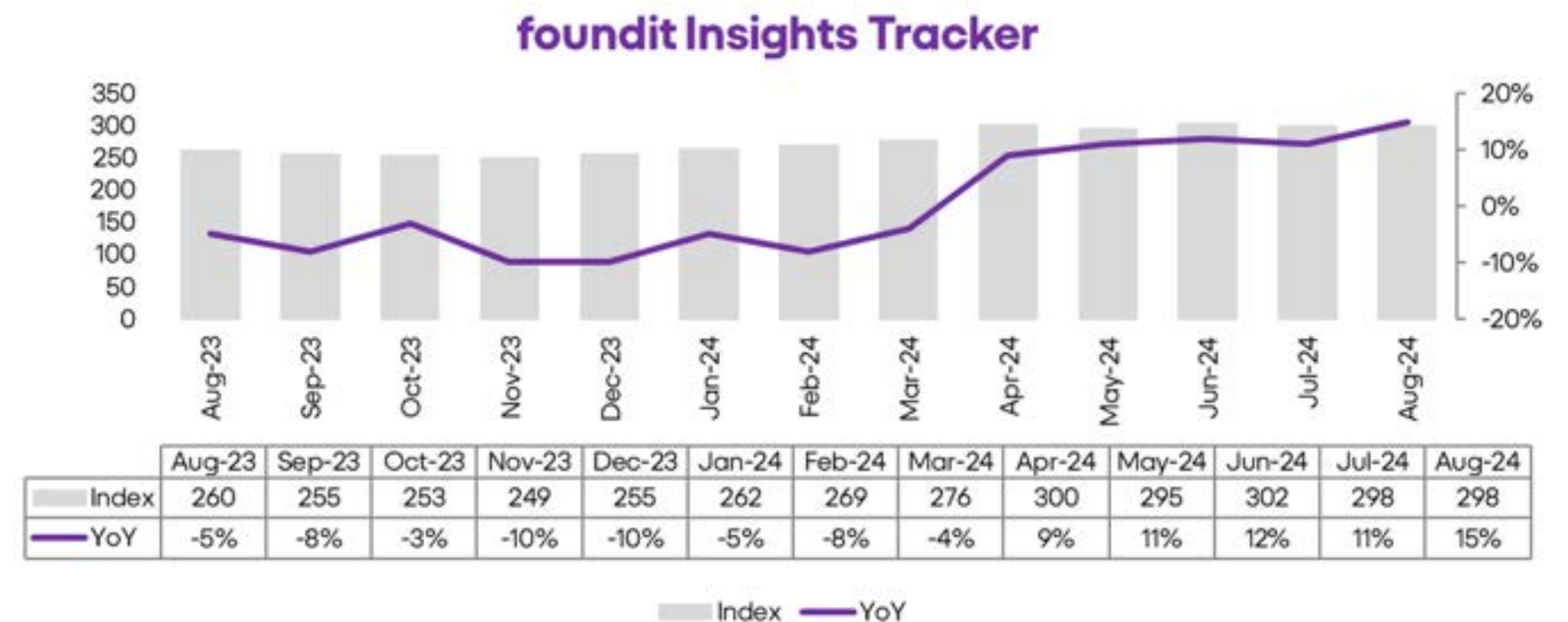
E-Recruitment soars 15% annually in August '24

The online hiring activity sustained an upward growth trajectory with a robust 15% annual growth. The overall hiring activity has been resurgent since the start of this financial year. The tracker has captured annual progressive growth in the major employment-generating sectors, such as Manufacturing, IT, Healthcare, and Media and entertainment.

Despite a slight 1% month-on-month decline, the overall hiring activity remains strong, signaling confidence in economic recovery and growth.

The job outlook in India is promising, with a strong focus on innovation and sustainability across various sectors, bolstered by recent government initiatives. The government's push for digital transformation, skill development, and infrastructure projects is driving growth, making it an opportune time for job seekers and employers alike.

The tracker observed an increase in recruitment activity across 17 out of the 27 monitored industries on an annual basis in August 2024.

The **Consumer Electronics** sector continues to show impressive annual growth, driven by advancements in AI and IoT that enhance convenience and connectivity.

Innovation and changing consumer preferences are shaping the future of tech, with a focus on sustainable materials and energy-efficient products. This is driving demand for sustainability roles, especially in Tier-2 cities.

The **Media & Entertainment** industry is seeing a resurgence, with **14% annual growth and an 8% rise in the last six months..** Increased demand for digital marketing, social media, content creation, and video production professionals is fueling this revival. Emerging technologies like AI, VR, and data analytics are opening new opportunities, with gig roles in graphic design, writing, and video production making up 26% of the gig market.

Despite a 2% monthly dip, **Marketing & Communication roles (+22%)** show strong annual growth, driven by the need for digital expertise. Performance analytics and AI-driven strategies are particularly in demand, with significant hiring seen in Delhi/NCR (+20%), Jaipur (+11%), Kolkata (+9%), Mumbai (+8%), and Pune (+13%).

IT continues to lead hiring growth, with a 3% MoM and 9% YoY increase. The sector plays a critical role in driving digital transformation across industries. Tier-2 cities like Jaipur saw the strongest momentum, with a 31% surge in IT hiring.

Hiring surged across 11 of 13 cities year-on-year, with Coimbatore (+33%) and Bengaluru (+27%) leading the way. Delhi/NCR (+20%) and Kolkata (+10%) also saw notable gains.

"The IT-Software & Services sector has shown strong growth, with a **23% annual increase** and a **19% rise over the past six months**. Metro cities like Bengaluru recorded a 5% growth last month, while emerging hubs like Coimbatore saw a 4% increase. This expansion is primarily driven by the high demand for software development roles, which account for 46% of the IT job market. The sector's growth is fueled by digital transformation across industries, surges in cloud computing, AI-driven innovations, and businesses upgrading their technological infrastructure.

Looking ahead, the IT sector is poised for continued growth, with the expansion of Global Capability Centres (GCCs) set to drive further job creation and reinforce India's position as a global IT hub."

- GCC job growth has been remarkable, with a CAGR of 27.66%, rising from **151,723 jobs in 2021 to 315,624 by August 2024**.
- Emerging technologies like **Robotic Process Automation (RPA), Cloud Computing, AI/ML, Blockchain, Analytics,** and **Cybersecurity** have accelerated growth.
- The expansion of GCCs is set to continue, especially in **Bengaluru, Hyderabad,** and **Pune**, driving demand for specialised IT talent and further reinforcing India's role as a global IT hub.

About the report

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since January 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since February 2014.
