

Key Highlights of the Month

Malaysia sees 22% Year-on-Year surge in hiring activity for July 2024

- The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) demonstrated a significant upward trend, with the index climbing from 78 in July 2023 to 95 in July 2024, reflecting robust growth and increased hiring activity over the past year.
- The tracker reveals a strong month-over-month growth, with the index experiencing a 10% rise, moving from 85 in June 2024 to 95 in July 2024, indicating a sustained momentum in hiring activity.
- The latest tracker data reveals a 14% growth in online hiring over the past six months, with a significant spike in hiring sentiments this month. Malaysia's job market is projected to stay stable throughout 2024, driven by business expansion and government initiatives focused on upskilling the workforce to address industry skill gaps.




Hiring Trends – Industry*

9 out of 10 industries monitored by the Index reported an annual increase in hiring activity in July'24.

The Retail (+125%) sector saw a remarkable annual growth, largely driven by the surge in e-commerce and a strong demand for consumer electronics. This sector continues to lead the charts, reflecting the increased consumer focus on technology and digital shopping experiences. Similarly, Logistics, Courier/Freight/Transportation, Shipping/Marine (+45%,) and BFSI (+42%) exhibited significant annual growth, with the growing services industry. However, the latter registered a double-digit growth over the last month.

- The Production/Manufacturing, Automotive, and Ancillary (-10%) sector experienced a notable year-on-year decline in job opportunities, reflecting a downturn compared to the previous year.
- In July 2024, multiple sectors experienced substantial annual growth in hiring. The IT, Telecom/ISP, and BPO/ITES (+6%) sector saw a notable increase in hiring activity. Additionally, there was a significant rise in demand in Hospitality (+29%), Engineering, Construction, and Real Estate (+27%), and Advertising, Market Research, Public Relations, Media, and Entertainment (+26%), while the Oil and Gas (+2%) sector also reported modest annual growth after a continuous decline since April'23.




Hiring Trends - Functional Area*

In July'24, online recruitment activity saw an annual increase in 8 out of the 10 monitored functional areas.

The Sales & Business Development (+72%) professionals saw a remarkable increase in hiring opportunities across industries, with a 35% growth over the past six months. Followed closely by HR & Admin (+71%) roles, which experienced a boost in hiring, reflecting heightened hiring sentiment and stronger employee engagement. Also, Engineering/Production (+54%) roles observed a subsequent increase in demand in July 2024.

Traditional Hospitality & Travel (-53%) roles faced a steep decline as the sector shifted towards emerging roles. Meanwhile, Customer Service (-8%) roles experienced an annual dip, however a 16% month-over-month growth was recorded in July'24.

However, Purchase/Logistics/Supply Chain (+14%) roles surged annually, with an impressive 18% growth over the past month marking a shift from a negative to a positive growth. Additionally, Software, Hardware & Telecom (+8%), Marketing & Communications (+46%), and Finance & Accounts (+41%) roles showed strong annual growth in July 2024.



Data & Methodology

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since March 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since March 2014. foundit has taken due care in compiling and processing the data available from various sources for foundit Insights Tracker (fit), but does not guarantee the accuracy, adequacy or completeness of any information and is not responsible for any errors or omissions or action / decision taken or for the result obtained from the use of such information.
