

Hiring Trends in Singapore

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
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Key Highlights of the Month Singapore's foundit Insights Tracker registered an 8% annual dip in hiring activity in July 2024.

- The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) shows a notable annual decline, with the index falling to 110 in July 2024, down from 120 in July 2023.
- Month-over-month, there has been a slight dip in hiring activity, signaling an uneven market trend.
- The tracker reflects that hiring activity in Singapore has shown a slight uptick over the past three months, despite facing a mixed economic landscape. While traditional sectors continue to grapple with challenges, optimism prevails among employers in emerging industries. The rise of the digital economy has fueled an increasing demand for upskilling initiatives, prompting companies to focus more on training and development. This shift aligns with the growing emphasis on creating a technologically advanced and flexible work environment, ensuring the workforce remains competitive and engaged.




Index — YoY — MoM

Hiring Trends – Industry*

8 out of 15 industry sectors monitored by the tracker witnessed growth in hiring in July'24 over the last month

- In July'24, the Education (+4%) sector experienced modest growth driven by increased demand for upskilling and reskilling, aligning with the global emphasis on continuous learning and development. Also, IT, Telecom/ISP, and BPO/ITES (+1%), and Healthcare (+1%) witnessed slight growth, with demand being driven by digital transformation initiatives and the ongoing need for technological infrastructure and support.
- On the contrary, Advertising, Market Research, Public Relations, Media, and Entertainment sector (-5%) marked the steepest decline among all monitored industries facing the headwinds. Additionally, Hospitality (-3%), and Import/Export (-2%) too experienced a decline in e-recruitment activities over the past month.
- Furthermore, Shipping/Marine (0%), Consumer Goods/FMCG (0%), Retail/Trade and Logistics (0%), Engineering, Construction, Real Estate (0%) and Oil and Gas (0%) remained quiet in hiring activity. While Production/Manufacturing, Automotive, and Ancillary (-1%) and BFSI (-1%) sectors saw a marginal dip in July 2024.




Hiring Trends - Functional Area*

7 out of the 12 functions tracked showed consistent hiring activity in July'24 on a MoM basis

- In July 2024, the demand for Legal (+1%) professionals saw a slight increase over the last month with a notable annual increase, maintaining a positive growth trajectory. Additionally, Finance & Accounts (+1%), Sales & Business Development (+1%), Customer Service (+1%), and Engineering/Production (+1%) roles each experienced a slight rise in e-recruitment activity, all reflecting a marginal uptick compared to the previous month.
- Conversely, Software, Hardware, and Telecom (-5%) professionals experienced a decline in hiring activity, with a drop both month-over-month and year-over-year, placing them at the bottom of the chart. Additionally, Marketing & Communications (-3%) and Hospitality & Travel (-2%) roles saw a decrease in demand over the last month in July 2024.
- Among others, HR & Admin (0%) and Purchase/ Logistics/ Supply Chain (0%) saw muted demand while Healthcare roles (-2%) observed a decrease in recruitment activity over the last month.





Data & Methodology

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since March 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since March 2014. foundit has taken due care in compiling and processing the data available from various sources for foundit Insights Tracker (fit), but does not guarantee the accuracy, adequacy or completeness of any information and is not responsible for any errors or omissions or action / decision taken or for the result obtained from the use of such information.
