## **Hiring Trends in Singapore**

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
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## **Key Highlights of the Month**

foundit Insights Tracker in Singapore registered 5% decline in e-recruitment activity in September'24 on a Y-o-Y basis

- In September 2024, the foundit Insights Tracker (fit) showed a 5% decline over the same time last year, with the index slipping to 110, compared to 116 in September 2023.
- In the sequential analysis, index displayed an expansion of 7% over the last month, as August'24 marked the index at 103.
- The tracker shows a marginal drop in hiring activity over the past six months. The job market has reached a phase of stability, with quit and hiring rates leveling out. However, the imbalance between job openings and hires remains a challenge for businesses trying to secure critical talent. Looking ahead, projections indicate a potential recovery in the coming year.



## **Hiring Trends – Industry\***

Hiring increased in 12 of the 15 industry sectors monitored by the tracker over the last month.

- The Education (+4%) sector saw a resurgence this month, leading e-recruitment activity among all monitored industries. Also, a positive hiring trend was seen annually fueled by investments from both the government and private sector. Additionally, hiring in the Retail/Trade and Logistics (+3%) sector and the Import/Export (+3%) sector also experienced an uptick over the last month.
- Conversely, the BFSI (-2%) sector experienced a sequential decline in demand, registering a drop and ranking lowest in hiring activity. Similarly, the Advertising, Market Research, Public Relations, Media, and Entertainment (-1%) sector saw a marginal decrease, following a period of higher recruitment activity last month.

The industries that saw movement in growth in recruitment activity in September'24 were - IT, Telecom/ISP, and BPO/ITES (+1%), Government/ PSU/ Defence (+1%), Production/Manufacturing, Automotive, and Ancillary (+1%), Healthcare (+1%) and Hospitality (+1%) while Shipping/Marine (0%), Consumer Goods/FMCG (0%), Engineering, Construction, Real Estate (0%) and Oil and Gas (0%) saw no change in hiring demand over the past month.



### Hiring Trends - Functional Area\*


6 out of the 12 tracked functions saw increase in hiring activity in September'24 over the last month

- The Marketing & Communications (+30%) professionals saw a remarkable hiring demand both annually and in the past month. The changing marketing dynamics and the omnipresence strategy has created huge demand for these professionals, particularly for roles in content management. Also, job roles in Purchase/Logistics/Supply Chain (+29%) and Finance & Accounts (+11%) saw a notable increase as the retail sector gained momentum. Additionally Legal (+9%) roles continued to experience a positive growth trend.
- On the other hand, the demand for Sales & Business Development (-13%) roles saw a significant decline over the last month. The shift is observed in most of the sectors as businesses are increasingly investing in digital marketing reducing the need for traditional sales roles. Additionally, Software, Hardware, and Telecom (-9%), along with Healthcare (-10%) roles, have also seen significant decreases in hiring demand, both on a monthly and annual basis, positioning these sectors at the bottom of the hiring index.
  - However, **Customer Service** (+2%) and **Hospitality & Travel** (+2%) functions noted an increase in job opportunities while **Engineering/Production** (-7%), **HR & Admin** (-9%) experienced a drop in September 2024.

### **Data & Methodology**

The foundit Insights Tracker (fit) is a comprehensive monthly analysis of online job posting activity conducted by foundit.in. Based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large, representative selection of online career outlets, fit presents a snapshot of employer online recruitment activity nationwide. In its earlier form (as Monster Employment Index), it gave a broader view of hiring trends by industry, function, location and experience levels. In its new avatar, it provides next-level insights on recruitment trends and tracks developments in demand for key skills, roles available and salary range on offer in the market.

In order to avoid excessive monthly fluctuations, the index is calculated using a volatility-adjusting formula. We publish the data in a volume index format with the base value of 100. The index describes changes in the level of online job demand against the baseline. An increase in the index indicates growth in online job availability and suggests an increase in the demand for employees by employers.

Foundit Insights Tracker (formerly Monster Employment Index ) was first launched in India in May 2010 with data collected since November 2009 followed by Gulf in April 2011 with data collected since November 2010; Singapore in May 2014 with data collected since March 2011; Philippines and Malaysia in May 2015 with data collected since March 2014. foundit has taken due care in compiling and processing the data available from various sources for foundit Insights Tracker (fit), but does not guarantee the accuracy, adequacy or completeness of any information and is not responsible for any errors or omissions or action / decision taken or for the result obtained from the use of such information.
